Re: Update on proposed Francophone School

Dear Scenic Acres Residents,

I would like to update Scenic Acres residents on the progress of my communication with the school boards regarding the proposed Francophone school. The Calgary Board of Education (CBE) and the Calgary Catholic School Division (CCSD) have presented potential alternative sites for the Francophone School. I have contacted the councillors in the area, and they in turn have contacted the community associations regarding a potential site in their community.

The overall protocol of this review will be dealt with in the Joint Use Coordinating Committee (JUCC). The JUCC consists of: The City of Calgary; CCSD; and CBE; the Southern Alberta Catholic and Calgary Public Francophone School Boards. The committee will review all the options with the Francophone Board. If a site is agreed upon, community consultation will be conducted. After consultation and upon agreement, all procedures and legal requirements will be conducted through the JUCC.

I would like to thank the CBE, the CSSD and the Francophone board for cooperating to seek the best solution for the community and students. Although all decisions will ultimately be made by the boards, I will continue to assist in facilitating the process through the JUCC protocol and the Municipal Government Act.
