Re: Francophone School Outcome

Dear Scenic Acres Residents,

Two weeks ago, the Joint Use Council Committee (JUCC) conducted an analysis of all the available school sites as an alternative to the Scenic Acres site. The analysis included the suitability of each site for school use, access to the site, and the location within the NW quadrant for the Francophone School Board.

The Francophone Board took the report from the JUCC, conducted another analysis and discussed it with their board members. The Francophone Board decided, based on a determination of their own needs that they would remain at the current location.

I am disappointed with the outcome. Unfortunately, I have exhausted all the options within the jurisdiction of the municipality of The City of Calgary. I am disheartened that the process for selecting new school lacks the process of consultation. I do not agree this is the best outcome for all stakeholders. I hope further options can achieve this. In my previous letter to the Honourable Sandra Jansen (May 4, 2014), I asked if the Francophone Board does not pick any of the proposed locations, if she could investigate options at the provincial level.
